There are an estimated 700,000 young carers in the UK, some as young as 5 years old


In Wiltshire :

Young Carers

Under 25 years old

A young carer is a child or young person (aged from 5 to 25) whose life is affected by caring for at least one family member, over and above just 'helping out'. This could include for:

- Parent (s)
- Grandparent (s)
- Sibling (s)
- Close relatives (s)

What do young carers do ?

- Household chores: washing, cleaning
- Preparing and cooking food
- Personal care: helping to dress, feed or wash
- Giving medication
- Communicating on behalf of other: signing
- Ensuring someone's safety
- Providing emotional support
